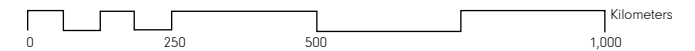

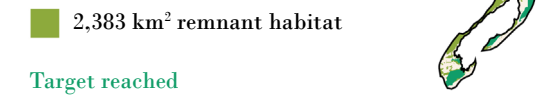
7. Northeastern Congolian Lowland Forests



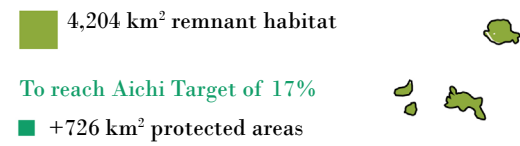
9. Northern Congolian Forest-Savanna Mosaic



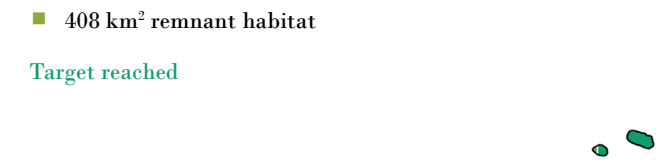

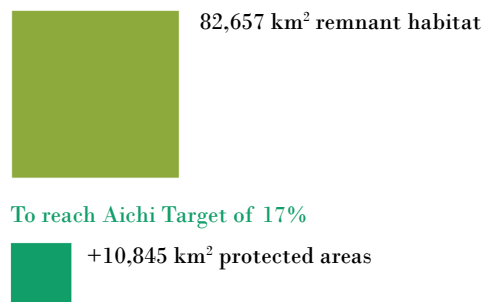

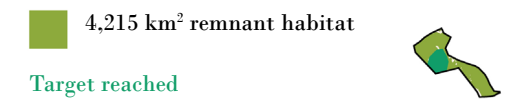

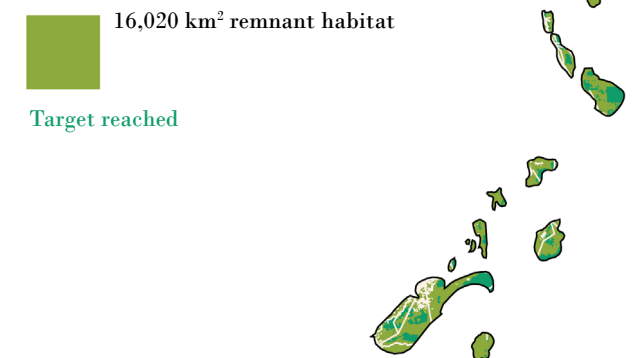

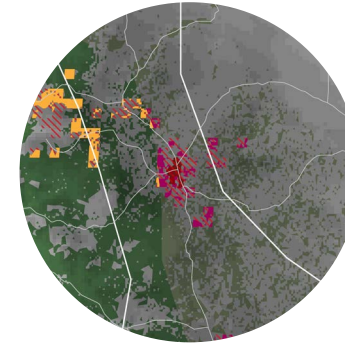
13. NAJRAN, SAUDI ARABIA

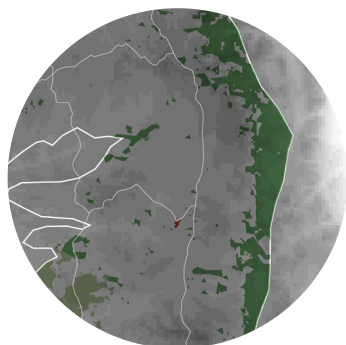

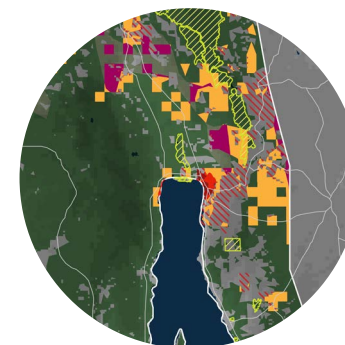
14. SANA'A, YEMEN

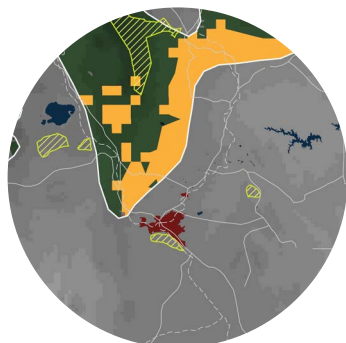
